



Subbamma one of the prominent women of Madras. After attending the meeting addressed by Gandhi, became politically active book led in the province. She addressed various meetings of women and exhorted them to wear khadhi and spin in their leisure time. She further wanted them to realize that they were wasting a huge amount of money on foreign cloth. She also organized pickeling in front of the foreign cloth shops appealing shopkeepers to stop dealing with foreign cloths and stock khadi only. She also formed a women's cadre of Deva Sevikas (God devoted servants). Because her active participation in the movement she was arrested and sent to jail. As a matter of fact she was the first women of the region to go to jail.

Ambujammal:

Ambujammal was also engaged in all programmes of the movement based on the principle of the nonviolence. She organized various meetings, processions, etc. and also solved Khadi and picketed foreign cloth and liquor shops.

Durgabai:

Durgabai, aged twelve, was another inspired organized and a tireless worker, who worked for the cause of the freedom in such a tender aye. Gandhiji's visit to Godavari district was a turning point in her life. She donated her jewellery and went around the town selling khaddar and enlisting volunteers for the progress of the movement. She also arranged a meeting to devadasis (God devoted women) to be addressed by Gandhiji after raising fire thousand rupees. The meeting was attended by around the thousand devadasis. Inspired by Gandhi's fervent appeals these women took off their ornaments and

donated twenty thousand rupees and also took a vow to wear swadeshi hence forth.

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Rukmini Lakshmipathi:

She was played very Important role in Tamil Freedom Struggle, when she took to spinning as part of the Swadeshi movement. She was one og the outstanding members of the working committee of the Indian National Congress and Deputy Speaker of madras Legislative Assembly. As she was deeply interested on political movements, she made up her mind to participate in the Individual Satyagraha, which she considered as a necessary one, took part in the agitation which broke out in the year 1940-1941. She was one of the prominent members of the Indian National Congress, she was placed in "A" class prison. She was the first women Satyagrahi in madras, when she was taken to jail, she declared that, "Let the women India follow the leadership if Mahatma Gandhi and maintain the honour and dignity of our Motherland. She Continued to play a remarkable role in the the congress politics till the end. She was participate in the quite India movement. She also went from place appealing people to participate in the movement. Like Rukmani Lakshmipathi, dhamayanthu, Janaki Ammal, Kahalakshmi, Suryavathi Ammal and others also seriously entered in the mass revolution of 1942 and they were arrested.

Prospects and Challenges of Women freedom fighters:

The women's involvement in the freedom struggle. It leads to the development of their social condition. The women freedom fighter were Encouraged inter-caste marriage and widow remarriages. Jagadambal helped the downtrodden people and she herself created awareness to the women. Women freedom fighters faced number of problems.
